#### **OUR SCHOOL**

Westpark Co-op Preschool is operated as a non-profit, non-denominational enterprise founded and incorporated since 1963 by a group of dedicated parents. We offer a guided play philosophy which allows maximum freedom for the children in their choice of activities and companions. We aim to help the children become socially aware and provide varied experiences and stimulating fun such as academic themes, introduction to French, dance, science, gardening, concerts, sand/water tables, cooking, baking, guest speakers, field trips and much more!

The classroom is run by a qualified teacher and the school is run by the parents. We offer two programs: Parent & Tots for 2-year-olds and Preschool for 3 & 4 year olds. The tuition fees and fundraising are the sole sources of revenue and they cover insurance, materials & the teacher's salary. Thus, we have a Board of Directors to ensure the school and meetings are run efficiently, but all parents are equal and should all participate in whichever way they are able. All parents are expected to attend board meetings as most decisions are made together.

#### **OUR TEACHER**

Kristina Stojsavljevich Maric teaches the Parent & Tots class and the Preschool program. Kristina graduated with a Bachelor of Education from the Ontario Institute of Education in Toronto, Ontario and a Bachelor in Sociology from Brock University St. Catharines, Ontario. She's been an educator for over 20 years and has taught Junior and Senior Kindergarten, Grades 1 and 2. Additionally, Kristina has her Specialist Certificate in English as a Second Language. She is a mother of two beautiful boys and enjoys spending time with her family, visiting farms and zoos both near and far! She also enjoys gardening, baking, refurbishing furniture and singing in her church choir.

### DUTY DAY (FOR PRESCHOOL PROGRAM ONLY)

Each parent takes turns for duty days. As this is done on a rotating basis, the more children that attend, the less often each parent will need to come in. The schedulers are responsible for preparing the duty day schedules, taking into account the parents' availabilities. If for any reason a parent cannot make their day, it is their responsibility to find a replacement to switch duty days with. When it is your day to come in, that day becomes your child's special day which makes them very happy as they get special tasks to do! Parents on duty should be prepared to help the teacher with supervision, crafts and snacks. Should you need to bring a younger sibling with you on your duty day, they are invited solely if they do not disrupt the teacher and other children.

#### **SNACKS**

Each child is to bring their own nutritious peanut and nut free snack ex: fruit / veggies, crackers, cheese etc. with a bottle of water. Each item should be labelled with the child's name including their lunch box. On your child's birthday, you can bring cupcakes or a cake. Always remember to verify food allergies.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Snow storms – if the LBPSB has cancelled classes, the school will be closed. You may also receive an e-mail from a Chairperson/Teacher if a class is cancelled due to an emergency or illness. Please advise the teacher if your child will be absent from school (text message or e-mail).
